The aircraft overran the end of runway 26 on landing run. It ended up on top of a large lava heap which covered the northern end of the runway since the 2002 eruption of the Nyiragongo Volcano. About 20 people on board were injured, local reports said. At the time visibility may have been obscured by low clouds south of the city. The aircraft was recently acquired from American Airlines. At the time of the landing, the runway was wet from recent rainshowers. The available runway length is limited to only 1.995 metres. Since April 2009 works are underway to clean the northern end of the runway from the solid lava rocks. A task of which international aid organizations like German Welthungerhilfe predicts to last until 2012 when the Goma Airport will be able to handle larger jets again. Compagnie Africaine d'Aviation is among the *European Black List* of banned airlines because of safety concerns.
