The aircraft crashed and burst into flames after it overran the end of runway 24 at Mangalore-Bajpe Airport. The aircraft ran down a steep embankment and broke apart in a forest where it came to rest about 100 meters further. It is understood that there were 158 fatalities. The accident location was difficult to access for fire fighters and rescue equipment. At the time of the crash, light rain was falling and local visibility was reduced to 6 kilometers. No abnormal situation was reported by the crew prior landing. Early investigation revealed the pilots may have landed long. Mangalore's runway 24 is 2.448 meters in length and equipped with 60 meters overrun areas at both ends. It was built in 2006.
